Health care is a necessity that not everyone can afford. Those who do not have insurance often work several jobs to make ends meet and do not qualify for Medicaid benefits or other assistance. Many patients have private insurance with high deductibles and co-pays they cannot afford.

Lake County Free Clinic exists to address unmet health care needs for anyone who has limited access to health care. We provide care free of charge, serving people who are uninsured, under-insured, or otherwise unable to obtain health care.

We are proud to be a provider of exceptional quality of health care and follow current standards of practice. All of our healthcare providers are board-certified and represent top Cleveland-area hospitals, including Cleveland Clinic, Lake Health and University Hospitals. Our staff is friendly, compassionate and mission-driven.

Appointments are required for patient visits and appointment availability varies. We offer limited weekend and evening appointments.

We do not provide walk-in or emergency care; if a patient feels they need to be seen immediately, they should call 911 or go to the nearest Urgent Care or Emergency Room.

We provide a wide variety of general medical care services for adults and children, age 2 and up. *If your concern is not listed below, we may still be able to help—call us!*

Chronic Care

We offer ongoing treatment for chronic diseases including, but not limited to:

- Diabetes
- High blood pressure
- Breathing problems (asthma, emphysema, COPD)
- Thyroid disorders
- Autoimmune disorders
- Depression and mild anxiety

Acute Problems

- Fever
- Sore throats
- Colds and coughs
- Acute sprains and muscle strains
- Bladder infections
- Pink eye
- Rashes

Preventive Care

- Work physicals (not ODOT)
- Pediatric physicals, age 2 and older
- Head Start physicals
- School, sports and camp physicals
- Personal nutrition and physical exercise counseling
- Education on deep breathing and meditation

On-site Lab

We provide basic lab work; we can also fill prescriptions for lab work from other providers.

Vision Screenings

We offer qualifying patients vision screenings and referrals to Prevent Blindness for a free eye exam and a free pair of glasses.

Adult Dental Care

Our adult dental care is limited to tooth extractions. We can work with you to find a dentist who will meet your other dental needs.

frequently asked questions

Do I have to make an appointment? How?

Yes, appointments are required. Call 440.352.8686 to speak with a member of our staff, or leave a voicemail with your full name, phone number and concern. We are unable to accommodate walk-ins or emergencies.

Do I have to live in Lake County ?

No! We will see anyone, no matter where they live - we are the only free clinic serving Lake, Cuyahoga, Geauga, and Ashtabula counties.

What do I have to bring with me? Do I have to get “signed up”?

You do not need to bring anything with you; the clinic does not require specific paperwork. However, to help with getting free medication, we would appreciate you bringing your pay stubs or tax returns. It is helpful for you to bring a list of any current medications you may be taking.

How much does it cost?

We ask for a \$20 donation at time of service, but no one is refused care if they are unable to pay. We are not a government-funded organization; we are a nonprofit 501(c)3 stand-alone clinic and funding is provided by the generous support of individual and corporate contributions, United Way, private foundations and volunteers.
